### PERSONAL PRONOUNS

Singular (one)	
I	The Speaker or writer.
You	The person in front of me.
He	One male person (man, boy, etc.)
She	One female person (woman, girl, etc.)
It	One object, place, animal.

Plural (more than one)	
We	One person or more than one + I
You	One person or more than one in front of me.
They	A group of men, women, objects, places, animals.
