A / An

USE: with COUNTABLES in Singular.

Example: There is A plum.
There is AN apple.

Some

USE: With Countables and Uncountables in AFFIRMATIVE sentences.

Example: There is SOME sugar.
There are SOME apples.

Any

USE: With Countables and Uncountables in NEGATIVE AND INTERROGATIVE sentences.

Example: There isn't ANY sugar.
There aren't ANY apples.
Is there ANY sugar?
Are there ANY apples?
