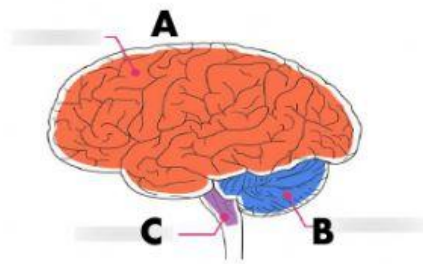
**I have a wonderful body
