Today we are going to make a snowman! Follow the instructions.

### How to Make a Snowman from Recycled Materials


#### Materials:

1. one old, white sock
2. scissors
3. sand
4. one small piece of fabric
5. buttons of different sizes
6. two shoelaces or pieces of string
7. glue

#### Instructions:



1. First, cut the sock in half. Be careful with the scissors!



2. Then tie one end of the sock with a shoelace or string. Make sure it is very tight.



3. Fold the sock inside out. Now you have a smaller sock.



4. After that, fill the sock with sand, rice or any other grain you can find.



5. Tie the other shoelace and make the snowman's head. The head should be smaller than the body.



6. Fold the other part of the sock to make the hat. You can use a small piece of fabric to make the scarf.



7. Finally, use small buttons to make the eyes and large buttons for the body.



8. Now, you have a snowman to decorate your house with or to give as a present.

**Be creative and add your own personal touch for your snowman. Look around your house, use your imagination, and turn trash into treasures!**  
**Christmas is a time to give, and by recycling we are helping the planet. Just imagine, if we all recycled, we could make a huge difference in the world!**
