Affirmative: Subject  TOLD  Object  TO  Infinitive...

Negative: Subject  TOLD  Object  NOT TO  Infinitive...

**REQUESTS:** "Please don't shout." "Can you open the window?" "Could you close the door?"

Affirmative: Subject  ASKED  Object  TO  Infinitive...

Negative: Subject  ASKED  Object  NOT TO  Infinitive...

**STATEMENTS:** "I usually go to work by car." "We can't speak fluently."

Subject  SAID  THAT...



Subject  TOLD  Object + THAT...

Direct Speech	Reported Speech
