This is the usual word order in questions:

question word	auxiliary	subject	infinitive
<i>What</i>	<i>does</i>	<i>this country</i>	<i>do for me?</i>
<i>Why</i>	<i>do</i>	<i>we</i>	<i>need a test?</i>

object	auxiliary	subject	infinitive
<i>Who</i>	<i>does</i>	<i>he</i>	<i>work for?</i>
<i>What</i>	<i>did</i>	<i>he</i>	<i>say?</i>

subject	verb
<i>Who</i>	<i>cares about these things?</i>
<i>How many people</i>	<i>describe themselves as British?</i>
<i>What</i>	<i>happened to patriotism?</i>
