

SIMPLE PRESENT OR PRESENT CONTINUOUS?

LET'S SEE!

Simple Present

Use:

- **Habits and routines**
e.g. I **wake up** at 7 every day.
- **Things that are true (facts)**
e.g. Argentina **is** in South America.
- **Permanent situations**
e.g. I **live** in Martinez.

Present Continuous

Use:

- **Something happening now**
e.g. I **am studying** for the test now.
- **Something happening at the present but not necessary at the moment**
e.g. She's **learning** Chinese at school.
- **Temporary situations**
e.g. They're **staying** in a great hotel in Mexico.

Simple Present

Form:

(Aff) Subject + **verb** + rest ...



e.g. I **wake up** at 7 every day.

(Neg) Subject + **Auxiliary Verb** + **Verb** + rest ...



e.g. I **don't wake up** at 7 every day.

(Int) **Auxiliary verb** + Subject + **Verb** + rest ... + ?



e.g. **Do I wake up** at 7 every day.?

Present Continuous

Form:

(Aff) Subject + **verb 'to be'** + **verb-ing** + rest ...



e.g. They **are learning** English now.

(Neg) Subject + **verb 'to be'** + **Verb-ing** + rest ...



e.g. They **are not learning** English now.

(Int) **Verb 'to be'** + Subject + **Verb-ing** + rest ... + ?



e.g. **Are they learning** English now?



Simple Present

Remember:

- Auxiliary verbs Interrogative:

DO / DOES

- Auxiliary verbs Negative:

DON'T / DOESN'T

IMPORTANT:

WE ADD AN **S** TO THE VERB IF THE SUBJECT IS 'HE', 'SHE' OR 'IT'. WHEN WE USE **DOES** WE DON'T ADD THE S TO THE VERB.

Present Continuous

Remember:

HERE WE DON'T USE AUXILIARY VERBS. BUT IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER THAT:

AM

I

IS

HE / SHE / IT

ARE

YOU/WE/ THEY
