

Appositives

An appositive completes a thought in a sentence. It is there to add detail to a noun or a pronoun.

Example:

My cat, Max, likes to push things on tables to the floor.

An appositive can also be a phrase (group of words).

Example:

The winter months, which are very cold in Canada, feel painfully long.

Put a comma before and after the appositive to separate it from the sentence. The only exception to this is if your appositive needs to be there for the sentence to be clear.

Example:

The artist Degas is renowned for his paintings of ballerinas.
