We all know that dark clouds usually bring rain, but did you know that if clouds are moving in different directions in the (2) , it can also mean rain?

The moon can help you predict the weather too. If you see a white cloudy circle around it at night, this is probably a cloud that will bring rain in the next (3) days. And if the sky is pink or red in the evening, there will usually be good weather the next day.

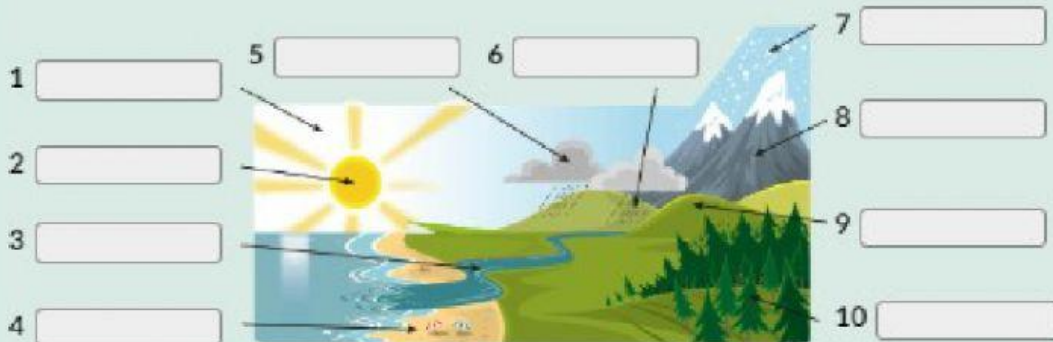
