INSTRUCTION 3: Match each concept with the correct definition.

SOLVENT

Substances that can be easily dissolve in water or other liquids.

SOLUTE

In this mixture the components are uniformly distributed. You can't see the ingredients.

SOLUTION

Is what you get when you combine two substances.

HOMOGENEOUS MIXTURE

Is a substance that dissolves in the solute.

HETEROGENEOUS MIXTURE

Is the result from the mix of a solvent and a solute.

SOLUBLE

Is a substance that is dissolved in a solvent.

INSOLUBLE

In this type of mixture, the components are uniform and can be physically separated.

MIXTURE

These substances don't dissolve in water.
