Like Terms Definition:

Combining Like Terms Review

$$4x + 8 - 2x = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$5w + 9q + 12q = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$6c + 12p - c + p = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$5 - 2v + 5v = -13$$
