Refrigerator-Freezer Troubleshooting

Problems

1. Motor starts and stops frequently.
2. Dishes vibrate.
3. Automatic icemaker does not work.
4. Water on floor or bottom of freezer.
5. Refrigerator has odor.
6. Interior light does not work.
7. Foods dry out.
8. Refrigerator does not operate.

Causes

- a. Temperature control starts and stops motor to maintain even temperature.
- b. Light bulb needs replacing or there is no power at outlet.
- c. Icemaker feeler arm is in Up position.
- d. Interior needs cleaning (check for spoiled food).
- e. The drain at the bottom of the freezer may be clogged.
- f. If the refrigerator vibrates, it is not resting solidly on the floor.
- g. If plug is secure and the refrigerator still fails to operate, check for burned out fuse.
- h. The food is not covered properly.
