### Regular Verbs: V + ed

walk - walked, paint - painted

cry - cried, spy - spied

love - loved, like - liked

stop - stopped, fit - fitted

### Irregular Verbs

go - went, eat - ate

drink - drank, drive - drove

buy - bought, cut - cut

am, is - was      are - were
