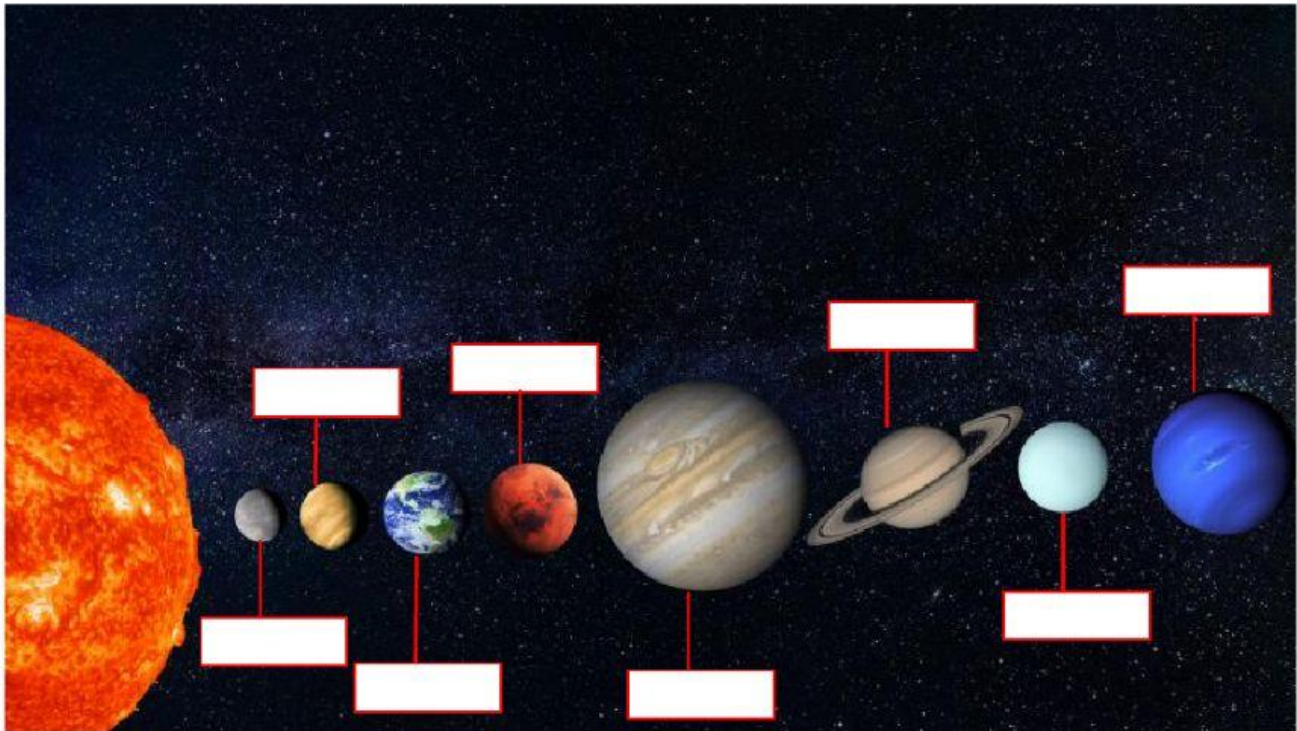


Our Solar System
