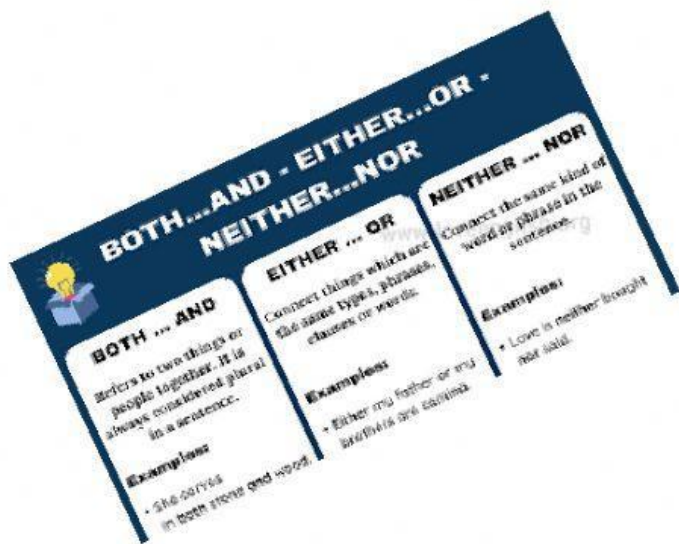




Neithernor – Either.....or – Both.....an
