*Hang has two past participle forms: hung and hanged with difference in meaning.

*For the Perfect Tenses, you must place **have**, or **has** or **had** before any past participle.

*Subject pronouns I, you, we, and they for **HAVE**. Example: You **have** + a past participle.....

*Subject pronouns He, she, and it for **HAS**. Example: She **has** + a past participle.....

***HAD** works with all the subject pronouns. Example: I **had** + a past participle.....

***Bear** has two past participle forms: **born** that refers **to give birth** and **borne** referring to **carry on or endure** something or a situation.
