

	Quick Access Toolbar	The quick access toolbar can be customized to hold your most frequently used commands.
	Dialog Box Launcher	Miniature buttons found on command tabs. Provides additional commands and tools associated with the group.
	Office Button	Located on the top left corner of the office window frame.
	Ribbon	Contains task-specific commands grouped together under command tabs.
	Message Bar	Security features cause the message bar to appear below the ribbon when you open a database outside of a trusted location. Enable the full content if you are sure the database is virus-free.
	Navigation Pane	Displays database objects such as tables, forms, queries, and reports.

	<p>Tables</p> <p>They are screen outputs of data arranged in various formats as required by the user. They can also be customized to include calculations, graphics, and other objects and are most often created for the purpose of printed output.</p>
	<p>Reports</p> <p>They are instructions that extract specific information from one or more tables. They can also be used to perform calculations.</p>
	<p>Queries</p> <p>They are the basic building block of the database. They contain information for related items and are broken down into individual units of information. Data is stored in rows and columns.</p>
	<p>Forms</p> <p>They are a group of objects that are used to assist the user in data entry.</p>
