Read following paragraph.

In the ancient world there were seven famous human-made structures known as the seven wonders of the world. Most of them were immense structures that required great engineering skill to build. Lists of the seven wonders varied, but there was one list that was the most common. According to that list, the seven wonders were the following: the pyramids of Egypt, the Hanging Gardens of Babylon, the statue of Zeus at Olympia, the Mausoleum at Halicarnassus (the tomb of a king), the temple of Artemis (Diana) at Ephesus, the Colossus of Rhodes (a statue), and the Pharos (lighthouse) of Alexandria.

Except for parts of the Mausoleum and of the temple of Artemis, only the great pyramids of Egypt are still standing.
