

Realiza las siguientes operaciones con fracciones (pon el resultado simplificado siempre que sea posible):



Ejemplo:

$$\frac{3}{4} + \frac{5}{6} = \frac{9}{12} + \frac{10}{12} = \frac{19}{12}$$

$\frac{4}{6} - \frac{6}{30} = \text{---} - \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.
$\frac{4}{14} + \frac{9}{10} = \text{---} + \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.
$\frac{12}{13} - \frac{16}{30} = \text{---} - \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.
$\frac{8}{5} + \frac{6}{12} = \text{---} + \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.
$\frac{6}{7} + \frac{30}{35} = \text{---} + \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.
$\frac{6}{6} - \frac{6}{20} = \text{---} - \text{---} = \text{---}$	M.C.M.

$$\frac{3}{4} \times \frac{5}{6} = \frac{3 \times 5}{4 \times 6} = \frac{15}{24}$$
