OUR PLANET'S BIOSPHERE

BIOSPHERE

- the part of the earth's crust, waters, and atmosphere that supports life.
- the ecosystem comprising the entire earth and the living organisms that inhabit it.

BIODIVERSITY

- Biodiversity, also called biological diversity, the variety of life found in a place on Earth or, often, the total variety of life on Earth.
- A common measure of this variety, called species richness, is the count of species in an area.

FOOD CHAIN

- A food chain represents the different levels of feeding relationships within an ecosystem.

FOOD WEB

- The connected food chains make up a food web.

EXTINCTION

- Extinction occurs when every single member of a species dies out and none is left alive.

LOSS BIODIVERSITY

- In recent years, the main cause of loss of biodiversity has been human activity. Some of the major threats include deforestation and pollution.

ENDANGERED

- Animals at risk of extinction are called endangered species.
