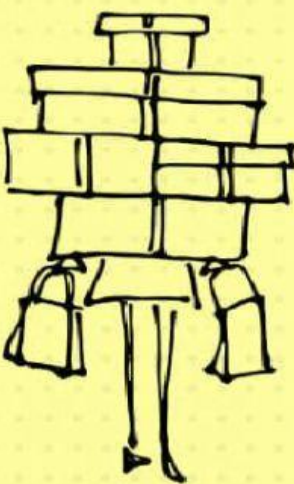

| AFFIRM.   | There is    | { | some ... | } | + Uncountable Nouns (always singular!) |
| NEG.      | There isn't |   | any ...  |   |                                        |
| INTERROG. | Is there    |   | any ...  |   |                                        |



**REMEMBER!** Uncountable nouns **DON'T** have plural form.
