

## Possessive Pronouns and Adjectives

A **possessive pronoun** shows ownership. It replaces a possessive noun.

A **possessive adjective** shows ownership and modifies or describes a noun.

possessive pronoun



This is Lupe's shirt. It is hers.

possessive adjective



This is Lupe's shirt. It is her shirt.
