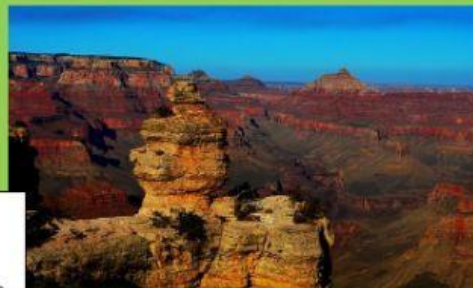

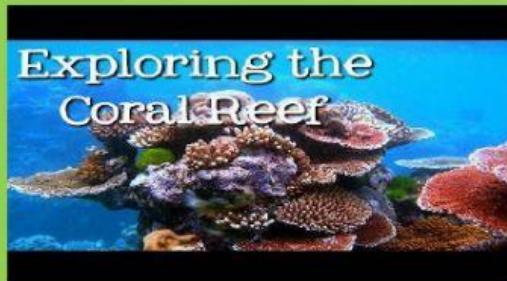
Grand Canyon

Grand means 'large' and *Canyon* means 'big crack in the ground'. Grand Canyon refers to a place in Arizona, United States, where this enormous crack formed in the ground because of the Colorado river.



Great Barrier Reef

Great Barrier Reef near the coast in Queensland, Australia has 14000 different plants and animals and is the biggest coral reef in the World. A coral reef is an underwater structure. It is made of many corals.



Mount Everest

This is a mountain which lies in the Himalayas, is the Earth's highest mountain.



The Northern Lights

Parícutin Volcano

This is a volcano at the top of a hill in the Mexican state of Michoacan. We know when it was formed and this is what makes this volcano special. It didn't stop erupting for nine years!

Victoria Falls

Victoria Falls, Africa is the largest waterfall on Earth. It is on Zambezi river between Zambia and Zimbabwe.
