**using**

If you aren't using your bike tomorrow, can I borrow it?

**built**

The new school will have been built by October.

8 I have tickets for the theatre tomorrow so I can't come for a meal.

**be**

I can't come for a meal tomorrow because I'll be going to the theatre.

9 Don't bother me because I will be busy all evening.

**working**

I will be working so don't bother me.

10 By the year 2000 there will be no trees left in this town.

**cut**

By the year 2000 they will have cut all the trees in this town.
