Objective: To write a How-to/Process Essay.

Use the following essay as a guide line to write your own How-to essay.

An April Fool's Day party can be fun. You can fool and surprise your friends by serving them this delicious punch. It looks so much like dishwater. Do not let your friends see you make the punch.

You will need these items; a bowl that holds three quarts, a package of green drink mix, one quart of orange juice, one quart of lemon soda, one pint of pineapple sherbet and a large spoon.

Process or How-to Essay

1. Introduce with a BANG!!! Explain- to them like this

2. Express to the audience like this...

"The ingredients or materials needed to make or do this are;...."

3. Explain what to do with the stuff

4. Conclusion Tell the reader how wonderful or exciting it is to make or do... and explain how it brings joy to you. Write it something like this... **Making this is enjoyable because not only do I get a tasty treat play the game I invented, but it makes me feel all grown up. I just love knowing that I can do things for myself.**
