

## (NOT) AS...AS / TOO... / (NOT) ... ENOUGH

### (NOT) AS ... AS

September is **as hot as** August. (equal)

The beach is **not as peaceful as** the lake. (not equal)

### TOO ... , (NOT) ... ENOUGH

I'm **too tired** to go diving. (excessive)

You're **clever enough** to learn Chinese. (sufficient)

It is **not hot enough** for swimming. (insufficient)

### THE CAPSULE HOTEL – JAPAN

Japanese capsule hotels have got very small rooms. They are <sup>1.</sup> **not as comfortable as** / **not comfortable enough** ordinary hotels because each capsule is <sup>2.</sup> **big enough** / **as big as** a bed and it's <sup>3.</sup> **large enough** / **too large** for only one person. A person can sit up and read or lie down and watch TV. He or she can't stand up because the ceilings are <sup>4.</sup> **not high enough** / **not as high as** for that. If the capsule is <sup>5.</sup> **not cold enough** / **as cold as**, the visitor can turn on the air-conditioner. Many of these hotels aren't <sup>6.</sup> **far enough** / **too far** from train stations, so they are convenient for travellers, and they are <sup>7.</sup> **too nice** / **nice enough** for Japanese workers to stay in them. In any case, it's probably never <sup>8.</sup> **as late as** / **too late** to find yourself a room for the night in a capsule hotel.
