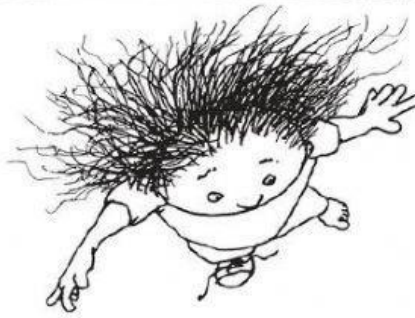


FALLING UP

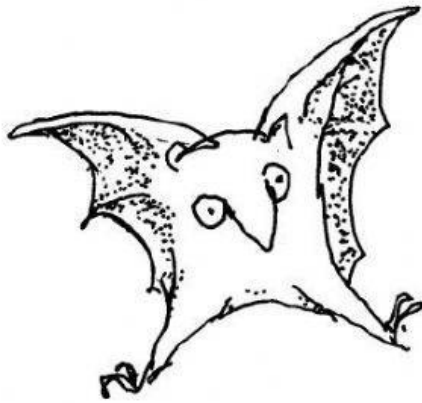
