



Reading Time

Have you ever eaten cheesy nachos? Where do they come from?



Most people answer Mexico, but that's only half correct. Mexico shares a border with the American state of Texas. Nachos come from Mexico, but cheese sauce comes from Texas—it's a "Tex-Mex" dish! This kind of fusion food, which combines ingredients from two countries, is becoming more common.

Thai duck curry is a very old example of fusion dish. It was invented hundreds of years ago in Ayutthaya and combines Thai red curry sauce with roast duck from China and grapes from Persia [now Iran].

Fusion food is also found in Europe. In the past, British people don't enjoy spicy food, but in the 1960s, a lot of Indian people migrated to the UK. They invented chicken tikka masala, a tomato and yoghurt curry that was not too spicy for the local people. Now British people are in love with curry!

So the next time you go out to eat, keep your eyes open: can you spot any fusion dishes?
