The set was broken.

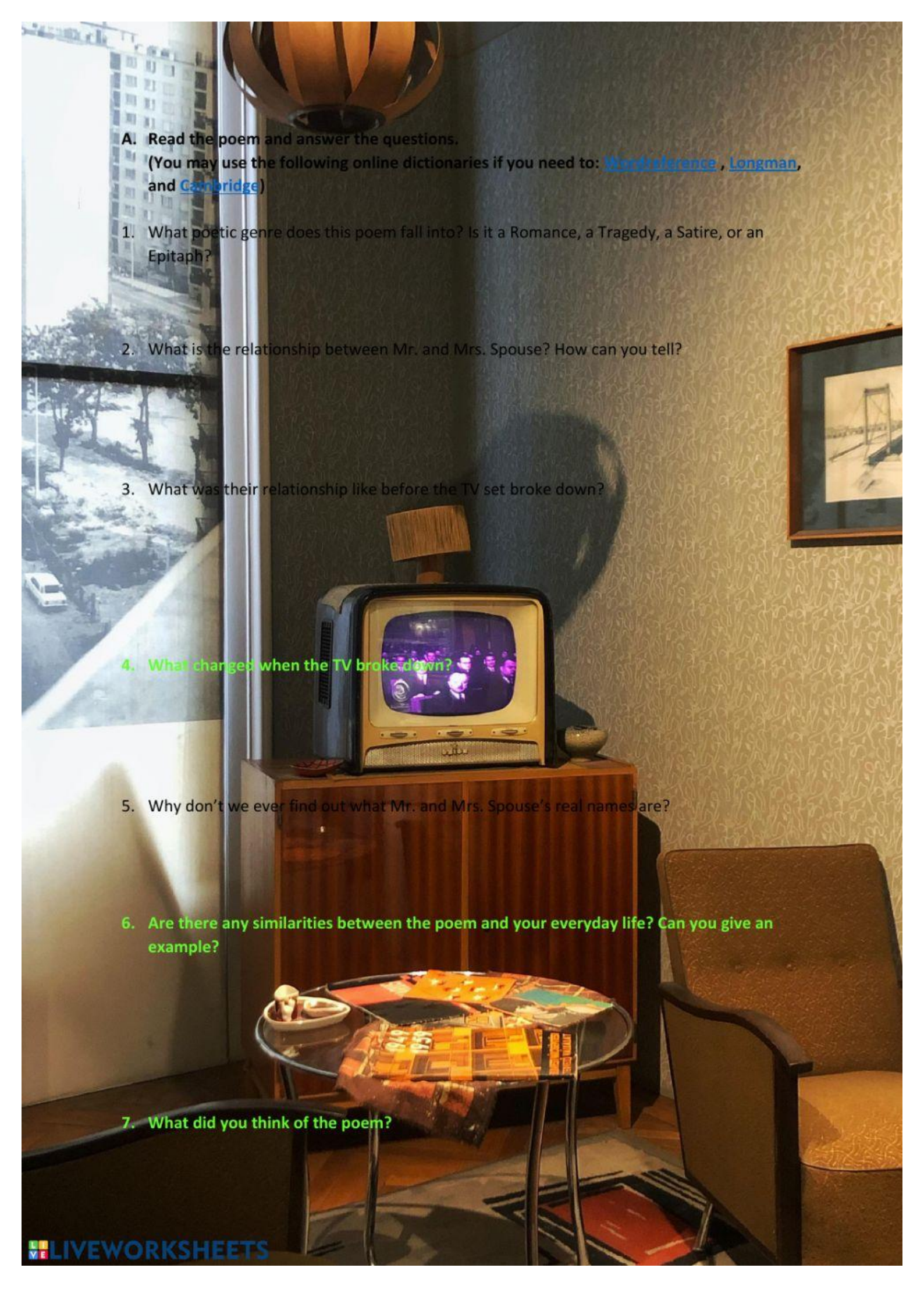
Then, "How do you do?"
