There's plenty of research that shows that the habits of those around you can determine your behaviour — the spread of obesity and smoking was attributed social influence.

However, not everyone became obese or started smoking which builds the case for free will.

Conversely, some kids were able to escape violent and poor neighborhoods in spite of hanging out with so-called 'bad influences' — one positive role model was enough to inspire them to do better.

BELONGINGNESS

is the human emotional need to be an accepted member of a group. Whether it is family, friends, co-workers, a religion, or something else, people tend to have an 'inherent' desire to belong.

REJECTION

However, some children born in abusive backgrounds may feel rejected by their own kind. Since the need to belong is so great, they find **belongingness** outside their circle, helping them to break free from the social environment they are born into!




