A girl **writes** a letter. or

Brenda **likes** the boy. or

verb (**object pronoun**)

A man **is hitting** it.

A boy **sees** them.

A girl **writes** it.

Brenda **likes** him.

Mr. Jones **helps** me.

Jennifer **wants** you to talk more in class.

The teacher **speaks** to us in English.
