

SOME/ANY

We use **SOME** for affirmative statements (+).

We use **ANY** for negative statements (-) and questions (?).

Example:

Have we got **ANY** apples?

Yes, we have got **SOME** apples, but we **haven't** got **ANY** bananas.

1) Did mum buy apples and pears?

She bought apples, but she didn't buy pears.

2) Is there rice in the cupboard?

Yes, there is rice, but there isn't pasta.

3) Do we need tomatoes for the soup?

Yes, we do. And we need peppers, too.

4) Have you got brothers or sisters?

I've got two sisters, but I haven't got brothers.

5) Did you see eagles at the zoo?

Yes, we saw eagles, but we didn't see owls.

And were there penguins?

No, there weren't penguins, but there were dolphins.
