If I keep so much money in my pocket.
6. She broke her leg so she couldn't go skiing. **BROKEN**
If leg, she could have gone skiing.
7. Unless he phones immediately, he's going to miss us. **IF**
He's going to miss us immediately.
8. He's afraid of heights so he didn't go climbing with us. **NOT**
If he he would have gone climbing with us.
9. Mark didn't tell her it was a secret so she told Jim. **HAVE**
If Mark had told her it was a secret, Jim.
10. She missed the concert because her car broke down. **NOT**
She wouldn't have missed the concert if down.
11. I can't open this lock because I don't have the key. **HAD**
If I open this lock.
12. He doesn't take his job seriously so he wasn't promoted. **BEEN**
If he took his job seriously, promoted.
13. He is not an honest person so he didn't tell the truth. **WOULD**
If he were an honest person, he the truth.
14. She doesn't have many friends because she's shy. **WERE**
If she have many friends.
15. She is sad because we forgot about her birthday. **NOT**
She if he had not forgotten about her birthday.
