

Use a related multiplication fact to find each quotient.

Draw a line to match.

1) $12 \div 6 = 2$

- $4 \times 6 = 24$

2) $24 \div 4 = 6$

- $6 \times 1 = 6$

3) $6 \div 6 = 1$

- $6 \times 2 = 12$

4) $30 \div 6 = 5$

- $8 \times 6 = 48$

5) $60 \div 6 = 10$

- $5 \times 6 = 30$

6) $48 \div 8 = 6$

- $10 \times 6 = 60$
