

THE SOLAR SYSTEM

The Solar System is formed by eight planets that orbit around the Sun. The first planet, and therefore the closest to the Sun, is Mercury. The second planet is Venus. This is the hottest of the planets. Third, we have the Earth, where we live. The fourth planet is Mars, the red planet, and the fifth one is Jupiter, the biggest of all the planets. The sixth planet is Saturn, with its beautiful ice rings, and the seventh is Uranus, which is the coldest of the nine planets. Finally, the eighth planet is Neptune, it takes it 165 Earth years to travel around the Sun!
