

## Present Perfect Progressive

+	subject + have/has + been + verb (ing)	I have been studying for 3 hours.
-	subject + haven't/hasn't + been + verb (ing)	I haven't been studying lately.
?	Have/has + subject + been +verb (ing)	Have you been studying?
