

A) BE: PAST SIMPLE AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE

We use *was / were* to describe situations in the past.

- He was at home yesterday.
- They were in Paris three weeks ago.

We use *was* for *I / he / she / it* and *were* for *we / you / they*.

We use *not* to form the negative.

- She wasn't (was not) in the kitchen.
- We weren't (were not) in the living room.

Affirmative	Negative	Contracted form
I was	I was not	I wasn't
You were	You were not	You weren't
He / She / It was	He / She / It was not	He / She / It wasn't
We / You / They were	We / You / They were not	We / You / They weren't
