

## SPOT THE DIFFERENCES - PREPARING A SPOKEN INTERACTION (PAIRS)

### FUNCTIONAL LANGUAGE – asking and answering about a picture

8. **How many** clouds \_\_\_\_\_ in the sky? There is / There are 5.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ any garden benches in the picture? \_\_\_\_\_? Yes, I can. / No, I can't. I can see one. I can see two.
10. How many flowers \_\_\_\_\_? I can see 2 flowers. / I can't see any flowers.
11. How many grass tufts can you see \_\_\_\_\_? I can see 2 tufts / 3 tufts.
12. Can you see any teacups \_\_\_\_\_? How many? Yes, I can. / No, I can't. 2
13. Is the handle of the green teacup \_\_\_\_\_? It is on the left. / It is on the right.
