BE A PORTRAIT PRO

These days, digital cameras make it far easier for untrained photographers to take great shots. But still a lot of things can go wrong! Then read on to find out how to take beautiful portrait photographs! First, find the perfect background. Before even turning on your camera, take a look around you and consider what your subject should stand in front of. For example, a doorway or the trunk of a tree can act as a great natural frame that will draw attention to the person in your photograph.

Experiment with different angles as well. Don't assume you have to take a portrait photograph from directly in front of your subject's face. Often, for example, side-view profile portraits or shots from above can capture the essence of a person very effectively.

The great thing about digital cameras is that you don't have to worry about wasting film. So don't stop snapping! Sometimes the perfect portrait photograph cannot be planned. You never know what masterpiece you might capture.
