Brief Explanation

**Must** is used to express obligation, give orders and give advice. It can only be used for present and future reference. When the past is involved, you **use have to**.

1. She **must** be mad!
2. You **must** be joking!
3. There **must** be some mistake

Application

1. To express obligation or duty. **E.g.** You **must** wear a seatbelt at all times
2. To emphasize the necessity of something. **E.g.** You **must** drive carefully.
3. Deduction - Sure that something is true (Certainty) **e.g.** Look at all of that snow. It **must** be really cold outside.
4. A strong recommendation. **E.g.** The ice cream here is delicious. You **must** try some.

**Mustn't = Prohibition**

- You **mustn't** use your phone while driving.
