Second Conditional

We use the **second conditional** to talk about unreal or unlikely situations. *Would* is the past tense form of *will*.

Structure:

If + subject + past simple ,	+ subject + would + verb
Subject + would + verb	+ If + subject + past simple

If	I was a pilot, she saw a spider, we were explorers,	I would fly to Hawaii. she'd run away. we'd discover a cave.
