Second Conditional

We use the **second conditional** to talk about unreal or unlikely situations.
Would is the past tense form of *will*.

Structure:

If + subject + **past simple**,

+ subject + **would** + verb

Subject + **would** + verb

+ If + subject + **past simple**

If	I was a pilot,	I would fly to Hawaii.
	she saw a spider,	she'd run away.
	we were explorers,	we'd discover a cave.
