Adverbs

Adverbs help us describe, change or add more information about a verb in a sentence. Learn more about their characteristics and uses with lots of examples!

There is a common characteristic that makes it easy to **identify an adverb in a sentence**, usually, they look like adjectives that end in **-ly**. Words like "*quickly*", "*happily*" or "*shortly*" are adverbs.
