1) Aliyah sold half of her comic books and then bought nineteen more. She now has 40. With how many did she begin?

2) Paul had some candy to give to his five children. He first took ten pieces for himself and then evenly divided the rest among his children. Each child received three pieces. With how many pieces did he start?

3) Asanji spent \$19 on a magazine and six notepads. If the magazine cost \$7, then how much was each notepad?

4) 309 students went on a field trip. Nine buses were filled and 21 students traveled in cars. How many students were in each bus?

5) Ming bought four hats. A week later half of all her hats were lost during a move. There are now only 10 hats left. With how many did she start?

6) Danielle's Bikes rents bikes for \$10 plus \$8 per hour. Lisa paid \$58 to rent a bike. For how many hours did she rent the bike?

7) Joe had some candy to give to his four children. He first took eight pieces for himself and then evenly divided the rest among his children. Each child received five pieces. With how many pieces did he start?

8) Amy bought a magazine for \$5 and four erasers. She spent a total of \$13. How much did each eraser cost?

9) Micaela sold half of her comic books and then bought sixteen more. She now has 28. With how many did she begin?

10) Norachai spent half of his weekly allowance on candy. To earn more money his parents let him mow the lawn for \$4. What is his weekly allowance if he ended with \$12?
