

It	+	are not	+	working
You	+	aren't	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »

Example: He is not (isn't) working in the garden.

Question

Am	+	I	+	working
« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »				
Is	+	He	+	working
		She	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
		It	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
Are	+	You	+	working
		We	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
		You	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
		They	+	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
