- 2 Like people, monkeys have hands and fingers. They point and scratch with them.
- 3 Many animals have spots on their body but zebras have black and white stripes.
- 4 A camel has a big hump on its back. The camel keeps fat in it, so it can live for 3 weeks without water.
- 5 A hippo's ears are at the top of its head so that it can hear well when it's in water.
- 6 Their webbed feet help penguins walk on ice and swim in water.
- 7 Pandas live in China. They have cute black and white faces. They have different colour eyes, and can't see very well.
- 8 An ostrich can run up to 65 km/hour. It has a big beak. It can't bite you, because it has no teeth.
- 9 Only male lions have long thick hair around their neck. It's called a mane and it protects lions when they fight.
- 10 Many animals have tails. A tiger's tail shows its feelings and helps the tiger to keep balance.
- 11 A giraffe's hoofs help them walk on the ground. The hoofs can be up to 30 cm long.
- 12 Bears have big paws. Bears dig and open logs with bugs inside, so that they can eat them.
- 13 Kangaroos have big strong tails. Their tails are like their third leg and help kangaroos to move.
- 14 All turtles have shells. The shells protect them and help turtles swim deep down into the sea.
- 15 Dolphins have a big fin in the middle of their back. It helps dolphins swim.
- 16 Some people love tarantulas; some people hate them. A tarantula's legs are very hairy to protect them.
