 - a) Joe will release a new song. (future with will)
A new song by Joe.
 - b) Stephanie's family make wicker chairs. (Present Simple)
Wicker chairs by Stephanie's family.
 - c) We sent some awesome e-mails yesterday. (Past Simple)
Some awesome e-mails yesterday by us.
 - d) Thomas is freezing pizzas for tomorrow. (Present Continuous)
Pizzas for tomorrow by Thomas.
 - e) Josh has pushed Andy. (Present Perfect)
Andy by Josh.
 - f) Lorna can throw a javelin far away. (modals)
A javelin far away by Lorna.
 - g) She writes children stories for free. (Present Simple)
Children stories for free by her.
 - h) Our parents brought many souvenirs from Poland. (Past Simple)
Many souvenirs from Poland by our parents.
 - i) Stan was offering his house as a payment. (Past Continuous)
The house as a payment by Stan.
