- 4 take something back to a shop and swap it for something else = **EXCHANGE**
- 5 someone whose job is to help somebody buy things= **PERSONAL SHOPPER**
- 6 previously owned by someone else= **SECOND-HAND**
- 7 a shop with second-hand items that gives the profit to people in need= **CHARITY SHOP**
- 8 looking at things in shop windows without buying anything= **WINDOW -SHOPPING**
- 9 keep and collect money rather than spending it= **SAVE UP**

IDIOMS

- 1 feeling down: **FEELING DEPRESSED**
- 2 be up to your / their eyeballs in: **TOTALLY OVERWHELMED BY SOMETHING**
- 3 get out of hand: **BECOME OUT OF CONTROL**
- 4 be on a high: **FEELING VERY GOOD**
- 5 being bitten by the ... (SHOPPING) bug: **BECOMING ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT/ OBSESSIVE ABOUT STH**
- 6 cost an arm and a leg: **REQUIRE SPENDING A LOT OF MONEY**
- 7 be hooked on: **ADDICTED TO SOMETHING**
- 8 retail therapy: **BUY THINGS IN ORDER TO FEEL BETTER**
