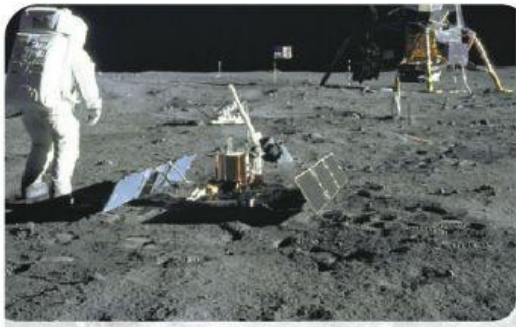




The Moon

The Sun

The Sun is a star. It is a big ball of gas. Astronauts can't visit the Sun because it is very hot. The temperature on the surface is 5,500 degrees centigrade. The eight planets go around the Sun. Mercury takes 88 days to go around, Mars takes 687 days and Jupiter takes 12 years!
