



Ara San Juan was a submarine in service with the Argentine Navy. Some tasks involved exploring areas to stop illegal fishing. It had been related to a lot of expeditions when unfortunately it sank in 2017. It went missing during a regular patrol with forty-four crewmen.



One year later the Argentine Navy reported that they had found the wreck of San Juan at a depth of 907 meters. The search and rescue operation involved more than 30 aircraft and ships from Argentina, the United Kingdom, Brazil, the United States, Chile and other countries. More than 4,000 personnel from 13 countries assisted the search. On 24 October 2021 a monument commemorating the 44 crew members lost was built to honor them and their families.
